

This deed made the 18th day of Sept. and in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty five, between Eliska Darden and Priscilla his wife executant and Wm. Lawrence on the other part, Wth Wth; that in consideration of the sum of forty dollars, it being for the lower land belonging to Priscilla Darden the wife of the said Eliska Darden lower land in the estate of the deceased husband Wth E. Lawrence. The said Eliska Darden and his wife Priscilla Darden do grant unto the said Geo. W. Lawrence, all the land known as the No. 4 Mills tract of land during the said Priscilla Darden's life, subject to a dower of the said Geo. W. Lawrence, all in the same one tract of land. The tract supposed to contain sixty acres more or less lying in the County of Southampton and in the State of Virginia, South East of the Portsmouth and Beaufort rail road, and bounded by James Mills and James W.
