Church South in which Peter's Church now stands, containing and laid out for five thousand one hundred and thirty six square yards of land together with all and singular the houses, woods, waters, ways, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise pertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the above mentioned and described lot or piece of land, situate, lying and being as aforesaid together with all and singular the houses, woods, waters, ways and privileges thereto belonging or in any wise pertaining unto them the said James Drury, John Williams, Robert Ireland, Isaac H. Davis, and Oliver M. Sykes and their successors in office forever in trust that they shall erect and build or cause to be erected and built thereon a house or place of worship for the use of the members of the Methodist E. Church South according to the rules and discipline which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the Ministers and preachers of the said church at their general conference; And in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times forever hereafter permit each Minister and preacher belonging to the said church as shall from time to time be duly authorized by the general conference of the Ministers and preachers of the said Methodist E. Church South or by the annual conference authorized by the said general conference to preach and expound God's Holy word therein. And the said William Prince doth by these presents warrant and forever defend all and singular the before mentioned and described lot or piece of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto them the said James Drury, John Williams, Robert Ireland, Isaac H. Davis and Oliver M. This Deed made the 20th day of April in the year One thousand eight hundred & fifty five, between Jas. E. Nicholson a Commissioner, appointed by the County Court of Southampton to close up the transaction of the late Alfred J. Little dec'd: who was Commissioner, appointed by the aforesaid Court to sell the above land of the late James L. & executrix to the purchaser a deed for the same he giving before the deed was executed, the said Jas. E. Nicholson has been directed by its instrument to said deed to receive the said deed on the payment of the sum of Five hundred dollars with interest from 21st December 1855, which sum having been paid of the receipt hereby acknowledged. The said Jas. E. Nicholson doth hereby
