This Indenture, made this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty five, between William Lankford of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and David Doyal of the same County and State of the other part, Witnesseth; that the said William Lankford in consideration of the sum of 225 dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid at or before the making and delivering of this presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained & sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said David Doyal his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land or situate lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation three hundred and thirty and one third acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows, viz. by the lands of Rich^d. Williams, Daniel Brattle and Richard Hills de^d, together with all and singular the reversions and reverses remainders and remainder, yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof. Do have & to hold the said three hundred and 30¹/₄ acres land the parcels therein purchased from David Doyal with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said David Doyal his heirs forever and the said William Lankford for himself and his heirs the said three hundred and thirty and one third acres land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said David Doyal his heirs & assigns free from the claims or claims of him the said William Lankford or his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall, will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
