

After Deed made this fifteenth day of October in the year one thousand eight hundred & fifty five, between John Bowers of the first part, John Cumples of the second part and Richard A. Virginia & Charles A. Virginia of J. D. Virginia of the third part, all three parts. That whereas the said Cumples did by deed of Trust dated June 16th 1853 (A.D.) and recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 25th June 1852, convey to the said Bowers (as trustee) a certain tract of land lying in said County containing twenty six acres more or less for the purpose of securing the payment of certain debts due to James B. Virginia amounting in all to about the sum of one hundred & sixty seven dollars. Now this deed of release with respect that the said debts have been fully paid and satisfied and the said Bowers and the said R. A. Virginia & Charles A. Virginia as aforesaid hereby release, and forever quit claim to the said Bowers all right, title & interest which they or either of them may have to the said real estate mentioned in the said deed of Trust.
