This Deed made this the 22nd day of October, 1855, between McWilliam Mc Cobb, Commissioner, of the first part, and McWilliam Landford of the second part, witness, that whereas, by virtue of a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County rendered at May term 1851, the said McWilliam Mc Cobb, was appointed a Commissioner to make sale of all the land of which Lewis Almond did seize and possession, and the said McWilliam Mc Cobb having given the notice of the time and place of sale required by said decree, did on the 19th day of June 1851, offer the said land for sale to the highest bidder, in a credit of nine months and the said McWilliam Landford became the purchaser for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and the whole of the purchase money having been paid, the said McWilliam Mc Cobb Commissioner aforesaid did by grant and convey unto the said McWilliam Landford the said tract of land of which Lewis Almond did seize and possession containing by estimation One hundred and fifty acres to him and his heirs forever. And the said McWilliam Mc Cobb, does hereby warrant the title to the said land against the lawful claims of all persons holding by or through him, but against the claims of no other person.
