hundred and fifty five, between Sarah H. Ford (commonly known by the name of  
Sarah H. Johnson) of the first part and John R. Rockelle of the other  
part; witnesseth; that the said Sarah H. Ford (or Johnson) grants for  
and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars (\$500)  
to the said grantor paid by the said John R. Rockelle (grantee) the receipt of  
which sum is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, and conveys with  
general warranty to the said grantee all that certain tract or parcel of  
land whereof the said grantor now resides lying in the County of Southampton  
(Virginia,) and contains one hundred and forty acres and more or less by the  
lands of Jacob Barnes on the North, east and South and west by the west  
by William E. Dray's Land, the said Land lies near, town, about  
One mile and half from the Penny Grove. The said grantor
