Deed to Kinchen
Williams

This Deed made the 25th day of December 1855, between L. W. Mason acting as
Commissioner under a decree of the County Court of Southampton pronounced
at its January Term 1855 in the case of Williams & vs Williams &
Kinchen Williams, before which that the said L. W. Mason in and
virtue of the Court of Five hundred and Eighty Dollars hath sold to the said
Kinchen Williams the tract of Land of which Rebecca Williams died seized
and possessed lying in the County of Southampton and bounded by the land of
John W. Mason, W^m Allen and others and supposed to contain one hundred
and eighteen acres. And the said L. W. Mason conveyed to Kinchen Williams
the above tract of Land with special warranty (Witness the following)
signature and seal.
