Coland of said County & State of the second part, witnesses that in consideration of the sum of Two thousand Dollars the said Turner and wife do grant unto the said Coland his heirs &c. a certain tract or parcel of land with all improvements and benefits thereto belonging, containing Six hundred and sixty acres to be the same more or less, and bounded by the lands of the said Joseph W. Coland on the north, on the East by the lands of Elizabeth Coland, on the South by the Mill Pond of Mrs. A. Persons and the West by the lands of William A. Jones which land with all improvements the said Turner & wife do warrant and defend the title to the said Coland his heirs &c. forever. Witness our hands & seals this day and year above written.
