This Indenture made and entered into on the 14th day of March in the year of our
Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty six, between Etheldred Daughtry of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Robert S.
Barnes of the same County and State of the other part, do hereby certify that
the said Etheldred Daughtry for and in consideration of the sum of forty
eight dollars and fifty cents to him in hand paid by the said Robert S. Barnes
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged. With granted, bargained and sold unto the said
doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Robert S. Barnes his heirs and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Pauls containing by
a late survey (which is one eighth acre) more or less the same more or less
bounded as follows; Beginning at the road at a new corner for said Etheldred
Daughtry in said Barnes' line, thence along said Robert S. Barnes' line S. 12th
E. 77 poles, thence N. 58th E. 79 poles to a white oak; thence S. 61st E. 12 poles
to a post oak, thence S. 59th E. 9 poles to a pine; thence S. 53rd E. 11th poles
to the said road; thence along the middle of said road the various courses
thereof (constituting) 10 1/2 poles to the beginning. Do have and Etheldred the
above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all appurtenances
the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him
the said Robert S. Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only
proper use and behoof of him the said Robert S. Barnes his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said Etheldred Daughtry for himself his heirs
Executors and Administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with
the said Robert S. Barnes his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns
that he will by these presents warrant and defend all the right and
title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
unto him the said Robert S. Barnes his heirs and assigns against the claims and demands of all and every other person
