It is thus the said Henry Bishop for and in consideration of the sum of fifty four dollars and 25 cents to him or him paid by the said Cordy C. Whitfield at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; Shall granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Cordy C. Whitfield, his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes, containing by a late survey thirty two and 1/8 Acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at a pine on path a run corner in John Hargraves line, thence along said Hargraves line S 25° E. 18 1/2 poles to a black gum a corner for said Cordy C. Whitfield, thence along his line down thence of a small branch 7 1/2 poles to another branch, thence S 86° E. 3 poles to a white oak; thence S 24 1/2° E. 5 1/2 poles to a small sweet gum, thence S 41° E. 11 1/4 poles to an oak stump at a path, thence along the path S 85° E. 42 poles to a run corner in said Whitfield's line; thence along a new line of marked trees N 44° E. 21 1/6 poles to the beginning; To have and to hold, the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with the appertinances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Cordy C. Whitfield, his heirs Executors, Administrators and assigns that he will by these by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with its appertinances against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
