This deed made this first day of March in the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty six, between Sprattley Williams, Virginia Brist & Leonidas Clary and his wife Leonida who before his intermarriage with the said Clary was Leonida Williams parties of the first part & Thomas H. Nugent party of the second part all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of four thousand five hundred and fifty dollars (\$4500.) paid to the parties of the first part, the receipt of which they hereby acknowledge, they the said Sprattley Williams Virginia Brist, Leonidas Clary & his wife Leonida do give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thomas H. Nugent and his heirs forever with general warranty the tract of land in the State of County aforesaid upon which the above named Sprattley Williams now resides containing five hundred and sixty eight & three fourths acres bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a black gum standing in the Indian branch a corner for Elizabeth Thompson, thence N 45° E 135 poles to a pine on the road near Dr. T. H. Nugent's house, thence S 82 1/2° E 9 1/4 poles to an oak stump, thence N 87° E 37 poles to an oak corner of Robt. Ridley's Co. 2d, thence N 12° E 22 poles to a pine gum, thence N 45° E 41 1/2 poles to a pine corner, thence S 26 1/2° E 50 poles to a road, thence S 12 1/2° E 28 1/4 poles to a pine stump, thence S 80 1/2° E 21 poles to a pine, thence S 69° E 7 poles to a red oak, thence N 82° E 88 1/4 poles to a white oak corner, thence S 45 1/2° E 63 1/4 poles
