to witness; That in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars, the
said Franklin Turner doth grant unto the said Thomas B. Powell all thights
title and interest which he the said Franklin Turner has in and to a certain
tract of land situated in Southampton County and bounded by the lands of
N. S. Francis, Brown S. Sykes, Littleton S. Powell and Eliza Dotter,
containing Seven hundred & twenty eight acres. (to the same more or less)
In the tract of land is contained the house (253 acres) of Nancy Barnes.
The said Franklin Turner covenants with the said Thomas B. Powell
that he will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness the
