This Deed made this 23^d day of April in the year 1856, between Jordan Stewart, feoffee, of the one part and William Whithead of the other part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars the said Jordan Stewart doth grant unto the said William Whithead a piece or parcel of land, being a part of the tract of land in which the said Stewart now resides and bounded as follows: beginning a small oak about thirty yards from the back of the hill a line tree between said Jordan Stewart & Robert Whithead thence the line between said Stewart & Robert Whithead the Main run of the aforementioned Swamp, thence up the Main run of said Swamp to the line of John Rove, thence along the line of said Stewart & Rove from the said Swamp a west course to a chink, thence along same course about thirty yards to a pine standing in a ditch, thence a straight line through the said Jordan Stewart's field to a small oak the beginning, containing three acres more or less. And the said Stewart warrants generally, Heirs & assigns, above conveyed. Witness the following signature & seal.

Norfleet together with the goods they purchased of the said Norfleet & Williams also the lot that the said Bell purchased of Richard Barrett and have taken a deed from said Barrett in the name of James N. Bell, the said lot having been purchased jointly by the said Mumfer & Bell, the said lot lying on the south side of the Seaboard & R.R. Road and in front of the lot now occupied by Messrs. Bellitt & Sellers containing one half acre as described by deed from said Barrett for which the said Bell & his wife are to give the said Mumfer a deed for one half
