This Indenture made and entered into this 2nd day of May A.D. One thousand Eight hundred and fifty six between Edward F. Murfee and Josephine C. his wife of the first part Chas. R. Randolph & R. H. Baker Jr. who are mutually chosen trustees of the second part, and James W. Murfee, Eliza A. Oliver, Wm. H. Lawrence and Ann W. his wife, Jacob Sonow and Mary R. Barrett (and Richard Barrett and Mary R. his wife, the said James W. Murfee, Eliza A. Oliver, Ann W. Lawrence, Harrietta Sonow and Mary R. Barrett being the children of Simon Murfee deceased of the third part, Thomas the said Simon Murfee departed this life on the 9th day of April 1855, having duly made and published his last will and testament bearing date on the 18th day of March 1855, and admitted to probate before the Circuit Court of Southampton County by which he devises and bequeaths to the said Edward F. Murfee a large portion of his estate real and personal; and whereas the said Simon Murfee during his life time did at various times pay for and on account of the indebtedness of said Edward F. Murfee divers large sums of money, all of which the said Edward F. Murfee admits and acknowledges, for which payments and engagements, the said Edward F. Murfee might be called upon and required to respond or pay to the said parties of the third part their respective proportions under the residuary clause of the said will; And the said Edward F.
