This Indenture, made and entered into this day of . 1856, between
Richard C. Gray of the first part, John Bacham of the second part, Rosey of Mungie
and Rose E. Pope of the third part, all of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia. Whereas the said Richard C. Gray is indebted to the said Rosey
of Mungie by bond bearing date the 1st day of May 1854, in the sum of five
hundred and twenty five dollars, subject to a credit of one hundred and thirty
two dollars & 45/100 paid 1st day of January 1855, also one other bond bear-
ing date 18th day of May 1855, in the sum of two hundred and seventeen
1856 Dollars and twenty five cents and being indebted to the said Rose E. Pope
November 17th by bond bearing date 13th day of December 1853, in the sum of six hundred
and fifteen dollars & 50/100. And said Richard C. Gray being willing and
desirous to secure the aforesaid debts and interest. Now this indenture witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further
consideration of one dollar, to him the said Richard C. Gray in hand paid
by the said John Bacham at and before the sealing and delivery of these
present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Richard C.
Gray hath given, granted, bargained and sold unto these presents
both grant, grant, bargain and sell to the said John Bacham his
heirs and assigns forever the following property, to wit, his pre-
sent growing crop of Corn, fodder, Peas, Cotton, Potatoes, & wheat
Also Thirtynine head of hogs, Fifteen sheep and their future increase, all
catt Timbers, Potlars &c to hold to him the said John Bacham
proper use and behoof forever upon trust nevertheless that
the said John Bacham shall at the request of either one of the
aforesaid parties after giving at least ten days notice of time and place of
sale sell at public auction all the property herein named, or so much thereof as
shall be sufficient to satisfy said debt and interest, amount of the proceeds first
pay the expenses thereof, then pay Rosey of Mungie debts with interest, then pay
Rose E. Pope debt with interest and the balance if any pay
over to the said Richard C. Gray or his legal representative
and the said Richard C. Gray covenant with the said John
Bacham that he is possessed of an absolute free simple
right to all of the property herein named and that he will
forever warrant and defend the same against himself and all
other persons whatsoever.
