

This Deed made the 16th day of May eighteen hundred and fifty six,
 between Chasey Bryant of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia,
 of the one part and Bailey Bryant of said County and State of the
 other part, witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Sixty
 dollars to the said Chasey Bryant by the said Bailey Bryant.
 She the said Chasey Bryant relinquishes and sells to the said Bailey
 Bryant all her right, title and interest in a certain tract of land lying
 in said County and bounded by the lands of Harrison Joyner and
 R. J. of Wm. Neely to which interest she is entitled by the death
 of Joshua Bryant her father, and she will forever defend the right
 against the claims of all others. Witness the following signature

This Deed made the 3rd day of May in the year 1856, between
 William B. Joyner of the one part and David St. Joyner of the other part
 witnesseth, that the said William B. Joyner doth grant unto the
 said David St. Joyner the following property to wit; One head of cattle sixteen
 head of hogs, twelve barrels of corn, and the present years crop of corn
 fodder, Ten mutts of in trust to secure Sam'l B. Kell as security
 for said William B. Joyner in a certain bond of eighty Dollars bearing
 date 3rd May 1856, and in favour of William Atkinson.
 The condition of the above obligation is such that if the said
 William B. Joyner should fail the above named bond then and in
 that event this deed to be null and void; if in default however
 of the payment of the whole or a part of the money then the said David
 St. Joyner after giving due notice proceed to sell the above
 named property or so much thereof as may be necessary to
 discharge the said debt.
