This Deed made this first day of April one thousand eight hundred and
 fifty six, between William J. Lawrence and Martha M. Lawrence his wife of
 Norfolk County Virginia of the one part and Mills L. Gray of Senthamp-
 ton County, of the other part, Witnesseth; That the said William J. Lawrence
 and Martha M. his wife, in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars
 do grant with general warranty unto the said Mills L. Gray and to his
 heirs and assigns forever the following real estate, to wit: A tract or parcel
 of land in Senthampton County containing by estimation three hundred and thirty
 three acres more or less and adjoining the lands of Pro. Rudliff's estate,
 Nathl Simmons, & others (and is the same land sold and conveyed by
 George A. W. Swaine & wife by deed on the 1st day of October 1845,
 to Mills L. Lawrence (and which on the death of said Mills L. Lawrence
 descended to his only child & heir, the said William J. Lawrence. And the
 said William J. Lawrence covenants that he has the right to sell and convey the land
 aforesaid, and that he will execute all proper assurances of the same.
