In trust to secure R. B. Travis on bond for twenty five dollars due 1st June 1856 and after the debt of the said Travis shall have been discharged then to secure C. F. Kello on a bond for fifteen dollars due 1st June 1857, & after the look on an apt for twenty dollars. Benj^a Travis and John Travis as sureties for the said Richard B. Travis in bond of sixty six dollars — unto due Benj^a Travis's estate the 1st Sept. 1856. M. D. Smith on bond for twenty one dollars of \$700 due 14th June 1856. If the said Richard B. Travis should pay the abovesaid debts upon application then and in that event this deed to be null and void; if not, the said Charles F. Kello shall proceed to sell at public auction for cash after giving proper notice the abovesaid property or so much thereof as may be necessary to discharge the above mentioned debts Witness the following signatures and seal
