Wigham of the second part Whereas by virtue of a decree of the Circuit Court held for the County of Southampton at the May Term thereof in the year 1856, pronounced in the case of Wigham vs. Wigham Executors & also the said parties of the first part were appointed Commissioners to convey the tract of land called "Clarique" in the proceedings mentioned to the said Wm. H. Wigham, in the payment of the sum of \$10,745.50 to the said R. A. & C. F. Wigham, Exors. of James B. Wigham dec'd.
