ampton and State of Virginia, and bounded as follows: to the north by the Lands

the West by the Lands of Valentine Brannell, also all my household and kitchen
furniture, all my stock and crop of every description, together with my Still
Applemill, iron cash, pincers, & Farming utensils of every description. In
trust to secure certain debts due to Robert M. Dolan, as follows: one bond of
One hundred & eighty two dollars & twelve cents due the 8th day of August 1856
also one other bond for four hundred dollars due the 15th day of August 1856
as well as all other monies that may be due and owing the said Robert M. Dolan by any
