

This Indenture made the 23rd day of August 1856, between Jno. W. Edwards of the first part and William M. Riggs of the second part and Jno. M. Gurley of the third part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Whereas the said Jno. W. Edwards is justly indebted to the said Jno. M. Gurley by bond bearing equal date with these presents in the sum of eighty two dollars, the said Gurley is bound as my security to a bond executed to Robert Dutton in the sum of sixty dollars payable the 16th day of June last, which debt the said Jno. W. Edwards is willing and desirous to secure and discharge by the said Gurley by reason of my indebtedness and his the said Gurley's liability as my security. Now this indenture witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid to the said Jno. W. Edwards by the said W^m Riggs at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Jno. W. Edwards hath given, granted, bargained and sold to the said W^m Riggs his heirs and assigns forever the following personal property, to wit: One several Mare, 1 shot Gun, 2 Sows and their future increase, and eleven shoats, my interest in Cattle in my possession all of my growing crop of Corn, fodder, pease, cotton and potatoes, farming implements, tools, household & kitchen furniture, my interest in a parcel of Ciderwood lying near the Rail Road, 1 Crop cut saw, 2 frames & drawing knives: To Have and to Hold the said property hereby conveyed to him the said W^m Riggs his heirs and assigns forever. The said Riggs shall permit the said Jno. W. Edwards to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of said personal property hereby conveyed until default be made in the payment of the above mentioned debt with interest to the whole so soon after the happening of such default. shall at the request of the said John M. Gurley (advocate) and sell at public auction the said property hereby conveyed, after giving due notice of the time and place of such sale; And out of the monies arising from the proceeds of such sale, first pay all cost of carrying into effect these presents, secondly pay off the bonds hereby provided for, the balance if any pay to the said Jno. W. Edwards, or any person he may authorize to receive the same. Witness our hand and seal, the day and date first above written

Interest to secure Richard S. Darden in the sum of forty five dollars, Leffe S. Barkham, James S. Bryant & Robert S. Britton due by notes & accounts. The said Richard S.
