Now this indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said John Barham at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Benjamin Hines hath given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell to the said John Barham his heirs and assigns forever, the following property, to wit: his present crop of Corn, fodder, peas, cotton, Oak nuts, and potatoes, one bay mare, Bloughs and gear, four hogs, one shot gun, bridle and saddle, two beds and all other household and kitchen furniture; To have and to hold to him the said John Barham's proper use and behoof forever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said John Barham shall at the request of either one of the aforesaid parties after giving at least ten days notice of the time and place of sale sell at public auction all the property herein named or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to satisfy said debts and interest and out of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof then pay the debts aforesaid with interest and the balance, if any, pay over to the said Hines or his legal representative. And the said Benjamin Hines covenant with the said John Barham that he is possessor of an absolute fee simple right to all the property herein named and that he will forever warrant (and defend the same against himself and all other persons whatsoever.
