

This Deed made the 13th day of October in the year, fifteen hundred and fifty six, between William Langford and William Hatfield all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas both, that in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to him and his paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said William Langford for both grants, bargains and sells unto said William Hatfield a tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State aforesaid, containing one hundred acres by the same more or less commencing at a birch tree a corner at the end of Matthew Harris's lane at the old pond a corner lies in Matthew Harris's lane between said Hatfield and William Langford and thence a new straight line of marked trees north west to a Black gum standing in the Cypress Swamp and bounded by the lands of Eliza Harris, William Drake, Patrick Bowe and Matthew Harris.
