 hundred and fifty six, between Jos. J. Darden, trustee, of the first part, and
 Orran Vaughan of the second part, all of the County of Southampton (and
 State of Virginia), both of which, that the said Orran Vaughan did on the
 11th day of August A.D. 1854, make a deed of Trust to secure a
 debt due to M^r Mungie of Seven hundred and fifty five dollars on demand
 that day conveying all his property both real and personal which
 deed was acknowledged on the same day in the Clerk's Office of this
 County and admitted to record, and assigned to Patrick Dole by the
 said M^r Mungie on the 18th September 1856. At October Court
