

This Deed made this 5th of January 1857, from Thomas J. Eley & wife Catharine to James Gray, his wife; that the said Thomas J. Eley & wife for the consideration of One hundred & Two Dollars to them paid by James Gray the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth grant, bargains and sell unto said James Gray his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing by Survey Thirty four acres more or less, it being same the which abuts on said Catharine in the division of her Father Benjamin Lamb Land. And said Thomas J. Eley & wife doth forever warrant and defend the right and title to said Land against the claims of themselves their heirs and all persons whatsoever. This Deed made this 13th day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty seven years between Thomas H. Ryman Granta after one part, and Robt J. Jones, Trustee of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Whereas; that the said Thomas H. Ryman doth grant unto the said Robt J. Jones, Trustee the following property, to wit: Two Horses Two Milch Cows, Two geldings and the increase of the same, Four Sons and Two daughters, Two Thousand pounds Black Tidde, or all Tidde that may be on the premises. Four Plough Hoes and gear, Horse Cart and wheels, four wood hoes, one grubber, Two Plough Hoes and two Cultivators one pair, Iron wedge one pole ax, Croft of seed species made by me this year 1857, on the Middle Brook Farm, Thirteen hundred pounds Salted Pork Three feather beds and clothing for the same, Two Tables, Six Chairs, one Cooking glass, Six Tumbles, one Cupboard Two chest Three Iron pots, one Spider, one oven, and one Iron pot each, all debts and monies due me at this time or that may become due, Tenant, one debt due me by John Comwell for Twenty three dollars and ten cents due 3rd November 1856, and amount of money due me in the hands of Saml Kello due on Land Warrant, one debt due me by Albert H. Rose also in trust to sum to Jessie R. Kindred, Two Bonds amounting to Three hundred and fifty nine dollars and 50/100 cents Tenant, one Bond due the 1st February eighteen hundred and fifty six for Two hundred and twenty nine dollars and 75/100 cents. One Bond due the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifty seven for seventy nine dollars and 75/100 cents. The said Thos. H. Ryman Granta warrants generally the said property hereby conveyed to the said Robt J. Jones.
