 bargain and sell to said H. D. Moore a certain piece of land lying in Southampton County
 and bounded as follows: Beginning at the corner tree between said Moore, Lawrence,
 & Jas. H. Judkins running west to a black gum at corner of old field thence
 west to a black gum, thence west to a Red oak, thence west to a red oak thence
 to a red oak in road, thence up road to Moore's line, containing by estimation two acres

 warrant and defend the title to said land against the claims of themselves their heirs and

This Deed made this 30th day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty six between
 W^m A. Jones and Charles Blattus for themselves and for all Brethren of the same place
 County, Virginia of the one part, and John R. Kilby chosen as trustee of the same place
 of the other part, Winchester; that the parties of the first part do grant unto
 the said John R. Kilby his executors and administrators the following property to wit
 a large number of crop ties got and suitable for the use of the Norfolk & Atlantic
 Rail Road Company in number twenty thousand or more not yet delivered and
 reserved to the use of the said rail road Company, now being on lands in the Counties
 of Norfolk, Hanover, Isle of Wight, Southampton and Dinwiddie (these being
 about fourteen hundred in Norfolk County or or near the old mill wharf; about
 three thousand in Hanover County on the lands of Jas. Lapsley and the Ferry Land;
 about eight thousand in Isle of Wight and Southampton Counties; about eight
 thousand five hundred in Dinwiddie County on the lands of John Little, Henry Cox
