Mr. Lockman & W^m A. Jones as also all damage or loss that may be in-
flicted by said Rail Road Company arising out of or resulting from any sub-
sequent alteration or modification of said contract now or hereafter made
with power to sell said property either publicly or privately for
cash or on credit as to the said John R. Kelly may seem best
or as requested to sell by W^m Mahone Chief Engineer of said Company or by
the President thereof and to account for the proceeds according to Law.
