

This Deed made the 24th day of December 1854, Between George C. Pope as trustee to a deed of trust from Richard C. Gray and wife, Louisa Gray to the said George C. Pope for the benefit of Samuel Dudley, dec'd of the first part (and John W. Mumfe of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Winchester; that in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and ten dollars paid to the said George C. Pope as trustee by the said John W. Mumfe, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said George C. Pope doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said John W. Mumfe the tract of land on which Richard C. Gray now lives lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton, containing by estimation Two hundred and thirty acres to be the same more or less (and adjoining the lands of Olisha Pope, Narcissus P. Pope, Ben E. Pope and the said George C. Pope together with all the right, title, interest claim or demand of in and to the above described Tract of Land and premises and with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said John W. Mumfe, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said George C. Pope as trustee for himself, his heirs, Executors and Administrators doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said John W. Mumfe his heirs, Executors Administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right, and title of the aforesaid tract of land and premises against the claims or demands of himself only.
