This Deed made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of 1856, between Allen Stephenson and his wife Laomia aforesaid party and Nathan Johnson purchaser of the second part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of eighty eight dollars and thirty seven and a half cents in hand paid the said Allen Stephenson and Laomia his wife do grant unto the said Nathan Johnson all their right and title to a certain tract of land whereof specially the land of Duffow Hart deceased seized and possessed containing twenty five acres be the same more or less including the old woods lower and is bounded by the lands of Richard Vaughan, Allen Stephenson and Nathan Johnson.
