

This Indenture made and entered into this Twenty Second day of December, One thousand eight hundred and fifty six, between Abram Riddick Trustee of the one part and James Cobb of the other part, Witnesseth; that on the 11th day of December 1856, the said Riddick expressed to publish a Sale entitled premises in the County of Southampton State of Virginia a certain tract of land conveyed by John St. Riddick to said Riddick as trustee on the first day of May last for purposes therein named (and duly recorded in the Clerk's office of said County on the 19th May) known as the Edwin Harrison place and the said James Cobb of Southampton County Virginia was the last and highest bidder at fifteen hundred Dollars, which sum was paid by the said Cobb to the said Riddick Trustee at or before the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and have bargained and sold unto the said James Cobb his heirs and assigns the above named tract of land containing two hundred and eighty acres more or less (and bounded on the North by the land of John Johnson dec. on the east by the Norway river on the west and south by the lands of the late William R. Battle the recessions, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part & parcel thereof). To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein conveyed unto the said James Cobb his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Abram Riddick Trustee for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Cobb his heirs and assigns free from the claim of him the said Trustee and his heirs forever conveying all right and title to said land that is vested in me as trustee and no more.
