 Edward Beaton of the City of Norfolk Virginia of the second part Witnessed
 that in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars, the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged, the said Joseph Jordan do grant bargain and sell unto the said
 Edward Beaton with general warranty all his right, title and interest in & to the
 thirty acres and late the property of Richard Jordan dec^d and known as the
 Martin tract and adjoining the lands of James Holt, Samuel Vick, Elmer & 3
 others & lying on the west side of the Syppes road leading from the Dam
 grove to the Syppes Bridge in Southampton County which right is or undivided
 third part of the said thirty acres and the said Joseph Jordan covenants with
 the said Edward Beaton that he hath the right to convey his interest
 in the said land that he the said Edward Beaton shall have quiet posses-
 sion of said land free from all hinderances or incumbrance and that the said
 Joseph Jordan will execute such further assurances of said land & his

This Indenture made the 21st day of December in the year one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty six, between Amy Pope of Southampton County and State
 of Virginia, of the one part and Jacob Williams of the same County
 and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Amy Pope in consid-
 eration of the sum of eighty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to her
 in hand paid by the said Jacob Williams at or before the executing and
 delivery of these presents, have bargained and sold and by these presents
 do bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns a
 certain tract or parcel of Land, bounded as follows: Beginning at a pine
 a corner standing in William Beaton's line, thence along the said Beaton's
 line a north course to a stub a corner standing in said Beaton's line thence a
 north course along Jacob Williams' line to a stub standing in Chas. Meals' line thence
 a south course to another stub in said Meals' line, thence along said Meals'
 line a west course to a pine a corner standing in Jacob Williams' line, thence
