Williams of the other part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, Witnesses; that in consideration of the sum of Five hundred & twenty dollars in hand paid by the said Zebulon Williams to the said Jeremiah O. Johnson & his wife, they the said Jeremiah O. Johnson & his wife do hereby bargain, sell & convey by general warranty to the said Zebulon M. Williams his heirs forever the following tract of land lying in the County of Southampton bounded & described as follows - On the north by the lands of S. C. James, on the east by the lands of S. W. Arnold, Smith east & west by the lands of C. F. Wagoner & on the west by the lands of C. S. Wagoner, containing by survey Three Hundred & fifty seven acres, formerly called Mrs. Mary James's tract & being the same purchased by the said Jeremiah O. Johnson of his brother Josiah Johnson as will appear by his deed bearing date 23<sup>rd</sup> October 1855. To have & to hold the above sold premises with all the privileges & appurtenances belonging to the said Zebulon M. Williams & his heirs forever. In Witness whereof, We, Jeremiah O.
