This Deed made this the 19th day of January 1857, between Jessiah O. Johnson & Indiana V. Johnson his wife of the one part, and C. F. Myghart of the other part, all of the County of Southampton & State of Va: Witnesses, that in consideration of the sum of three Hundred Dollars in hand paid by the said C. F. Myghart to the said Jessiah O. Johnson & Indiana V. Johnson his wife they the said Jessiah O. Johnson & Indiana V. Johnson his wife do hereby bargain, sell and convey by general warranty to the said C. F. Myghart & his heirs forever the following tract of land lying in the County of Southampton and containing by survey one hundred & fifty acres bounded & described as follows, on the east by a line beginning in the line between the lands of the said Jessiah O. Johnson & C. F. Myghart & running N. 14 E. to the land of S. C. James, on the north by the lands of said S. C. James on the west by the lands of C. F. Myghart & in the south by the aforesaid line bounded & known as the Hickory Neck portion of tract of land on which the late Mrs Nancy James lived & which the said Jessiah O. Johnson bought of his Brother Joshua Johnson as will appear by his deed bearing date 22^d October 1855. To have & to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges thereto belonging to him the said C. F. Myghart & his heirs forever. In Witness whereof we, Jessiah O. Johnson & Indiana V.
