F. Ezell and Sarah E. his wife by the said William Davis doth grant, bargain and sell unto the
said William Davis a certain tract of land containing One Hundred and forty nine and three
quarters acres more or less, said land bounded by the lands of Isaac Davis, William Davis,
R. H. & W. Mason and Gundalls Mill pond, the right and title to the said land in
the said John F. Ezell and Sarah E. his wife doth warrant and defend to the said
William Davis against the claims of any and all persons whatsoever to him and
his heirs forever. W. Davis our signatures and seals the date first above written.
