This Indenture made this twenty six day of Sept. Eighteen hundred and fifty six, between John De Hart
Guarantor for Robert Hart of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Richard
Borden of the same place of the second part, Witnesseth that the said party of the first part hath let out
and by these presents doth grant demise, and to farm let unto the said party of the second part all the
farm or land belonging to the said Robert Hart known as the William Borden lands and

land or premises with the appurtenances for the term of five years from the first day of January 1857
to the first day of January Eighteen hundred and sixty one at the yearly rent or sum of forty five
Dollars for each year and the said party of the second part doth covenant to pay to the said party of the
first the said yearly rent as herein specified yearly and equally payments half five Dollars for
each year and that at the expiration of the said term, the said party of the second part will quit and
surrender the premises hereby demise in as good state and condition as reasonable use and wear
thereof will permit. Damages by the elements or other accidents excepted, and the said party of the
first part doth covenant that the said party of the second part performing the covenants aforesaid
said shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy the said demise premises for the
