

This Indenture made and entered into the 20th day of December 1856 between Meritt J. Davis and his wife Mary V. the one part and William R. Stephenson of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby certify that for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and twenty Dollars then and lawfully paid to the said William R. Stephenson or his assigns, by the said Meritt J. Davis and Mary Virginia his wife have bargained, sold and granted unto the said W^m R. Stephenson or his assigns, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia commonly called and known as the Betty Ruddle Land containing by estimation, One hundred acres more or less and bounded by the lands of Melchor D. Ruddle, James D. Ruddle, Saml. R. Killee, W^m R. Stephenson and others and furthermore, one certain house and lot with its appurtenances near Bealton in the aforesaid County of Southampton and State of Virginia on the said landing from Bealton to Petersburg containing two acres and bounded entirely by the lands of W^m R.
