

This 3d instant made and entered into this month day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six, between Josiah W. Johnson & his wife wife, one part of William D. Bryant, of the
 part, all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Whereas it is agreed that the said Josiah W. Johnson
 & his wife doth assign for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars to be
 paid by the said William D. Bryant at or before the meeting and delivery of the same
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Josiah W. Johnson & his wife, who have
 granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said William D.
 Bryant his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land situated lying and being with in
 the said County of Southampton of State of Virginia and bounded by the lines of the Survey of John
 Johnson dec'd. Sam'l E. Battle, Joseph Culbert, Lewis Gold and others of the said County of
 said tract containing two hundred and eighty acres more or less together with all and singular the premises
 and appurtenances herein mentioned. To have and to hold the said tract unpaired and
 with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said William D.
 Bryant his heirs and assigns forever and the said Josiah W. Johnson for himself and his heirs
 and tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned to be
 bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said William D. Bryant his heirs and
 assigns and of all and every part and parcel thereof unto the said William D. Bryant
 his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well and truly be
 warrant and given defend by these presents. In witness whereof the said Josiah W. Johnson
 & his wife have hereunto set their hands & seals this day and date above written.

 of the first part and Elzabth Joyner, Trustee, of the other part witnesseth, that the said John W.
 Williams doth grant unto the said Elzabth Joyner the following property, the following tract of
 land in the County of Southampton V. bounded and described as follows on the north by
 the lands of S. E. James on the east by the lands of J. M. Arnold south east by
