This deed made this day of 1857 between Harrison D. Pope Commissioner of and John Whitehead. Whereas by a decree of the County Court of Southampton made at the December term 1853 in suit of Ignace D. Fisher vs. the said Harrison D. Pope was appointed Commissioner to make sale of a certain tract of land belonging to the estate of Nathaniel Fisher who was Nathaniel Defendant of a Nathan Pope dec'd lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing about three hundred acres and bounded by the lands of Nathan R. Bryant, Rhema Jackson & others upon the terms directed by the said decree and to withhold the title to the land until the whole of the purchase money was paid. And whereas the said Harrison D. Pope having duly advertised the time & place of sale did on the 16th day of January 1854 sell at public auction to the highest bidder the aforesaid tract of land and John Whitehead became the purchaser thereof at the price of \$850.00 and paying in cash a sum sufficient to pay the costs & expenses of the sale & decree executed three several bonds of equal amounts with good security for the balance of the purchase money and has subsequently fully paid off and discharged the said bonds. Now therefore in consideration of the promises and forbearance of one dollar to him the said Pope and paid to the said Pope either as aforesaid debt or grant with special warranty to the said John Whitehead the tract of land herein above mentioned and described.
