(grantee) of the other part; witness; that whereas the said grantor did his instrument  
to the said grantee as executors as aforesaid a deed of trust conveying to the said grantee  
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton known as the  
Middlebrook Farm containing nine hundred & twenty nine acres more or less and bounded  
as follows, to wit; by the lands of Edwin Beaton, Thomas Reddy & others theretofore  
having been admitted to record March 18<sup>th</sup> 1854 to secure the payment of the following  
debt to trust; one land for one thousand seven hundred & thirteen dollars dated July  
20<sup>th</sup> and due January 4<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1855 of me ... other land for the like sum of \$1715.00  
and in demand January 11<sup>th</sup> 1856. Now this deed witnesseth that the said John J.  
Hindman has fully paid and satisfied the whole of the said debt in the said land  
several together with all interest thereon. And that the said Bryant and I  
release, remit and discharge the said tract of land above described to the said  
Hindman as fully and entirely as if the said deed of trust had never been
