This Deed made the day of January in the year 1857 between James Johnson, David S. Walton,
and Maria L. his wife, A. T. B. Merritt & Jane S. his wife, William H. E. Merritt and
George W. Peet and Rosa his wife the said James Johnson, David S.
Walton & A. T. B. Merritt & William H. E. Merritt and George W. Peet constituting & forming the Com-
pany or Firm of Johnson Walton & Co. of the first part and Herman L. Brumley of the
part of North Carolina of the second, witnesseth, that the said James Johnson, David S.
H. Brumley, Walton and Maria L. his wife, A. T. B. Merritt and Jane S. his wife, William H. E.
Oct 19 1857 Merritt & Elijah W. his wife and George W. Peet and Rosa his wife do grant with general
warranty unto the said Herman L. Brumley all of the following lands with their improvements
buildings, mills, mill streams, appurtenances & hereditaments by: those several tracts of land
conveyed to James Johnson, John Gask, A. T. B. Merritt and William H. E. Merritt by
deed from John A. Smith and Mary H. C. his wife and Octavius A. Smith bearing
date the first day of November in the year 1857 and duly recorded in the Clerk's office of
the County Court of Southampton County or so much thereof as follows, to wit: all of that
one tract of land (except the Grove yard which is reserved) lying and being in the County of South-
ampton Virginia on the north side of Meherrin River adjoining the lands of Peter Edwards
John Whitehead and Mark G. Peete and containing from fourteen to fifteen hundred acres
more or less also so much of the following tract of land as lies in the state of Virginia at the whole
of said tract being described in the said deed from John A. Smith & wife & Octavius A.
Smith as in other tract of land lying on the south side of Meherrin River adjoining the tract
named tract and lying in the counties of Greensville Virginia and Southampton North
Carolina called the "Deloach Tract" adjoining the lands of Green Stanee and Joseph
M. Rogers containing four hundred and eight acres more or less also altho that
other certain tract or parcel of land conveyed to the said James Johnson, David S. Walton,
A. T. B. Merritt and William H. E. Merritt by deed from Joseph M. Rogers bearing date the
sixteenth day of March in the year 1855, and bounded as therein described viz: commencing on the
south bank of Meherrin River at Southeast angle of Greensville County & and at the point
where the boundary line between the State of Virginia and North Carolina crosses said river thence
by way of the boundary belonging to the R.R. Road for three rods straight away from the south
boundary of the said boundary line thence through the State of Virginia due East to its intersection with the south
boundary line of said R. R. Road Company one hundred feet to the north boundary of said
Company's land, thence following westward along said northern boundary of said Company's lands east at
an angle of fifty feet from the eastern line of said Rail Road into Southampton County.
It is to State our joint deposing this day planted on the line of the fence of said Joseph
M. S. Rogers, thence N 15 1/2 degrees E. 16 chains and 26 links to a Stunted oak -
blazed and harked standing on the bank of Meherrin River, thence down said River following
cours 20 links to low water mark of said River, thence down said River following
the natural course to the place of beginning excepting therefrom the 1/2 land included
