This deed made the 20th day of December in the year 1856 between James D. Bell and Emeline his wife of the one part and William Mumfere of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, do hereby certify that for and in consideration of the fact that certain articles of copartnership were entered into between the said James D. Bell and William Mumfere on the 26th day of March 1856 for the purpose of carrying on the mercantile business at Franklin Depot Va and that said copartnership has been dissolved by mutual consent, the said William Mumfere having agreed to take the entire stock in trade, the said James D. Bell and Emeline his wife do grant, sell and convey unto the said William Mumfere and to his heirs a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the Town or Village of Franklin Depot Va containing half an acre situate being the lot which was purchased by the said James D. Bell from Richard Barrett and which is more particularly described in the deed from the said Barrett to the said Bell, and in consideration of the premises the said James D. Bell and Emeline his wife do grant and convey unto the said William Mumfere their interest in said town and lot that was purchased by the said Mumfere and Bell from Alexander M. Russell. And the said James D. Bell and Emeline his wife do warrant generally the property hereby conveyed; but the said property is nevertheless to be liable for the payment of all debts contracted and made on account of the partnership existing between the said Mumfere & Bell.
