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 This deed made this the 31st day of December in the year 1856 between James N. Bell and Emeline his wife
 the aforesaid William Murfee of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia West,
 etc.; that for and in consideration of the fact that certain articles of copartnership were entered into
 between the said James N. Bell and William Murfee on the 26th day of March 1856 for the purpose
 of carrying on the mercantile business at Franklin Depot, it came to this said partnership
 has been dissolved by mutual consent, the said William Murfee having agreed to take the
 entire stock in trade, the said James N. Bell and Emeline his wife do grant, sell and
 convey unto the said William Murfee and to his heirs a certain lot or parcel of land lying
 in the Town or Village of Franklin Depot $\frac{1}{4}$ containing half an acre being the lot
 which was purchased by the said James N. Bell from Richard Barrett and which is more
 particularly described in the deed from the said Barrett to the said Bell, and in consider-
 tion of the premises the said James N. Bell and Emeline his wife do grant and convey
 unto the said William Murfee their interest in the above land that was purchased by the said
 Murfee and Bell from Alexander M. Huflett and the said James N. Bell and Emeline his
 wife do warrant generally the property hereby conveyed; but the said property is nevertheless
 to be liable for the payment of all debts contracted and made on account of the business
