This deed made this 10th day of June 1857, between Samuel Drury and wife to Joel Harris all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Received of said Joel Harris the sum of thirty three hundred and nine dollars and seventy eight cents in full for the purchase of five hundred and six acres of Land it being a part of the Land which William Prince formerly owned and sold at sale of at his widow's death, which sale was carried into effect by Samuel Harris and with the will annexed beginning at a sweet gum standing near the run of the three creeks a new corner thence along a new shopped line of trees 51 poles to a small standing cedar tree near the road, thence N 1/2 W 3 1/4 poles to a small walnut tree thence N 5/8 E 49 poles to a water oak, thence N 27° E 12 1/2 poles to a pine standing in a small Drury's line thence along his line to William Prince's line thence along his line to Joel Harris line, thence along his line to the run of the three creeks, thence down the margin of the run to the beginning. The said Drury conveys only such title and boundaries to the said Joel Harris as he conveyed to him by said Prince and no other.
