Johnson wife Sarah grantors of the one part and John Turner grantor of the other part Witnesseth that the said grantors for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty dollars paid by the said grantors to the said grantors the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged doth grant and convey to the said grantors the right title and interest in Zachariah Turner's land said land to contain one hundred and eighty acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of the Doerkman tract kept William Syner's said tract of land the widow Jane Griffith's called the Rockitt tract of land and William Larkford's Deal tract of land and George W. Bradshaw and Saterly Griffith. And the grantors as aforesaid warrant the title to the said tract of land hereby conveyed to the said John Turner and his heirs forever. Whitney of the second part, all of the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that whereas the said Irvin Griffitt was appointed a Commissioner by a decree of the County Court of Southampton County made at its Court 1856, and the said of James Snow died seized and possessed lying in the County of Southampton and that the said Irvin Griffitt Commissioner as aforesaid did sell the said land agreeably to the directions of said decree and that Lurina M. Whitney became the purchaser thereof by bidding the sum of \$200.00 that being the highest bid now in consideration of the premises the said Irvin Griffitt as aforesaid has then bargained and sold and by these doth grant and convey to the said Lurina M. Whitney the said tract of land of which James Snow died seized and possessed lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and twenty acres more
