W. Nefflet's lot lately purchased of Richard Bennett (in the North & East by the lands of Richard Bennett said lot containing by estimation an eighth of an acre more or less as is more fully described in the deed from Richard Bennett & wife to said Nefflet together with the two houses & situate thereon.
