This deed made this 9th day of October 1857, between Nancy Turner of the first part and Franklin J. Davis of the second part, Mr. Turkey of third part, whereas the said Nancy Turner is justly indebted to the said Mr. Turkey by bond executed into 2dnd day of December 1857 with S. R. Edwards security there to for the sum of Two hundred and Seventy-five Dollars 57 cents which debt and the interest thereon with the said Nancy Turner is willing and desirous to stave. Now this indenture witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money paid her in hand by the said Frank lin J. Davis which the said Nancy Turner hereby acknowledges, she the said Nancy Turner her self giving, grants, bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said Franklin J. Davis, a certain tract or parcel of Land containing Two Thousand and forty acres it being her desire allotted in the division of Thos. C. Turner estate, also one negro slave by the name of Stephen crop of corn, fodder, pease and potatoes, crop of Cotton, Stock of Hogs and Cattle, 1 Slave, House, Bed & Kitchen furniture, farming implements of every description together with all other property not specified. To have and to hold the said land and Crop to him the said Franklin J. Davis and his Heirs forever. Upon trust nevertheless, that the said Franklin J. Davis his heirs executors & shall permit the said Nancy Turner to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract or parcel of land and premises together with the personal property and slaves for her own propagation and behoof and to her the profits thereof to herself until default be made in the payment either in part of the whole, and then upon this further trust that he the said Franklin J. Davis shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he may be requested tell the tract of land and slave together with the other personal property hereby conveyed or such part as may be sufficient to satisfy and pay off the bond of interest hereby incurred after giving due notice after the time and place of each sale. The balance if any pay over to the said Nancy Turner or to any person who she may authorize to receive the same. Witness our hands and seals the day and date first above written.

Robinson of the second part, Wethersfield; that in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars cash int hand paid unto her the said Mary Frances Clark by the said William J. Robinson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; She the said Mary Frances Clark doth grant unto the said William J. Robinson his heirs and assigns, all her right, title and interest in a certain parcel or tract of land lying in the County of New Haven containing two hundred and seventeen acres more or less being the tract of land now in the occupancy of Joseph H. Prince and held by him during the life of Benjamin Clark, and is the land which was allotted to Elizabeth Dillier as her portion of Edmund Dillier's land; with general warranty.
