Elisha Wadsworth. And also to secure Samuel Kelle of Dutchess Co. Horse secured to a bond due Roll M. Vick acct^s of Polly Vick dec^d. And also to secure Samuel Kelle for an individual act amounting to Ten Dollars and seventy five cents. Now therefore in case the sd Abington Garden of W^m Johnson, Saml. Kelle and Patrick H. Rowe should at any time be liable to suffer from their said securityship or at any time the said Saml. Kelle for his individual account may demand the same the said Andrew J. Kelle set up and sell to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice the above named property. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of seven hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jno. M. Gulley at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold to the said John M. Gulley his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece of parcel land situated on the south side of Northway River near the Cypress Bridge and bounded on the north by the low grounds of said river on the east by the lands of said Gulley & the south and west by the lands of South H. Bishop and others containing one hundred acres more or less and known as the Exum Vick tract of land. To have and to hold the said tract of land and premises to him the said John M.
