

This Deed made the 2^d day of December in the year 1857, between Sally Hession of the one
 part and Alfred S. Stephenson of the other part, Witnesses, that the said Sally Hession
 doth grant unto the said Alfred S. Stephenson the following property on trust of land contain-
 ing by estimation 150 acres or less lying immediately in the fork of White
 water and Seacreek Swamps, bounded as follows on the north by the lands of John
 Spivy on the West by the lands of William Jenkins on the South by the lands of Seacreek
 Swamp on the east by Blackwater also one Horse Stock of hogs, Cattle,
 Corn, Food etc. Household and Kitchen furniture Two pair of Cart wheels
 one Cart and farming utensils of every description, in trust to secure to him
 due from J. Hession for the sum of twenty four dollars and 84 cents due the
 29th day of January 1851 one bond due to Alfred C. Hession for the sum of
 fifty dollars and 32 cents due the 30th day of October 1857, one bond due
 Robert M. Dales for the sum of fifty five dollars due 25th day of October
 1857, also one bond for three hundred dollars due the 2nd day of December
 due Robert M. Dales which bond is for money loaned (and to be satisfied
 prior to either of the above mentioned bonds, & so Witness the following
 signatures and seals the day and date above written.
