D. 1857 in our County aforesaid and having been examined by us privately and apart from her husband and having had the same decdly explained to her, acknowledged that she had willingly signed and executed the same and wished not to retract it.

We further certify that the said John H. J. J. did on the same day in our County aforesaid personally appear before us and acknowledge the said deed to be his act and deed and desire us to certify the same, his said acknowledgment to the Clerk of the County Court of Southampton together with the acknowledgment of his said wife in order that the said deed may be admitted to record. This Deed made the 16th day of November 1857, Between William Deale of the first part, and John P. Boykin of the second part. Witnesseth that the said William Deale doth grant unto the said John P. Boykin the following property one negro woman named Fanny and one named Georgianna all of my crop of corn, fodder & peas, all household & kitchen furniture and all of my cattle, hogs, sheep, & horses, in full to secure Allen Stephenson & Edwin A. Williams as sureties to be due Samuel D. Kelle, administrator of Emma Branch decd. and A. T. Williams for an individual act. Now if the said Allen Stephenson & Edwin A. Williams shall at any time think themselves liable to suffer from said suretyship or the said Edwin A. Williams from his individual act, the said John P. Boykin shall set up and sell to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice the said property before making any with the proceeds thereof pay off the said debt of the lat. of any pay over to the said Wm.
