

This Deed made the 19th day of March in the year 1856 between James C. Buittle of the one part and Jesse Carroll of the other part witnesses that in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars then and paid James C. Buittle doth grant unto the said Jesse Carroll a certain tract or parcel of land supposed to be three or four acres lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia and bounded by the lands of Mrs. E. Alman, Jesse Carroll, J. James C. Buittle &c. and he will generally warrant the land hereby conveyed to the said Jesse Carroll his heirs and assigns his signature and seal

Gaudinier of the County of Dallas and State of Alabama of the other part witnesses that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five Dollars to them in hand paid the said Richard Barrett & Mary R. his wife doth grant unto the said Barbary E. Gaudinier all their right, title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land known as the Samuel Robertson tract which the said Robertson only had a life interest in and lying near the Village of Franklin Depot bounded by the lands of R. Barrett, Mary R. Barrett, Jordan Edwards & others. The said Rich^d Barrett and Mary R. his wife warrants generally such title as is vested in them.
